# And this is how you participate in the AOK Specialist Programme:

In order to participate in the AOK Specialist Programme, you have to be enrolled in the AOK Family Doctor Programme. Your family doctor refers you to the specialist in any case. That, too, is at no charge to you as an AOK member.

Once you are participating in the AOK Specialist Programme, if you have health problems, you should only see specialists who participate in the programme.\* This ensures that you will be able to take advantage of the benefits of the AOK Specialist Programme.



## The AOK Specialist Programme comprises the following medical specialities\*:

- Cardiology for heart and cardiovascular diseases
- Gastroenterology for gastrointestinal disorders
- Psychiatry, neurology and psychotherapy for diseases of the nerves and the mind
- Orthopaedics/rheumatology for diseases of the locomotor or the musculoskeletal system and for systemic inflammatory rheumatic diseases
- Urology for diseases of the urogenital tract
- Diabetology for care of type 1 and type 2 diabetics and diabetes during pregnancy

Other speciality areas will be added.

\* It is not necessary to enrol for the individual areas of specialization: With participation in the AOK Specialist Programme, all the speciality areas listed are available to you from the start and as needed.



#### **Overview of all your benefits:**

- Your treatment is always state-of-the-art medicine, because all participating specialists take regular advanced training
- Because your family doctor and specialist work together, the treatment is always integrated and tailored to your personal needs
- You get an appointment within two weeks
- In urgent cases you get an appointment with your specialist on the same day, within three days for psychotherapists
- Doctor's office waiting times of 30 minutes maximum
- As a working person, you may take advantage of evening office hours once a week until 8:00 p.m.
- Many discounted medicines are without copayment for you
